SPEAKER'S BIO

MARGARET KENDI - Graduated from Pennsylvania State University with a Bachelor degree in Chemistry. Upon Graduation she joined Rohm and Haas Company in their Agricultural chemicals division. In 2001 she joined Bayer Material Science in their coatings research group. Over the last ten years she has performed both synthesis and applications work on various types of raw materials including: polyaspartic, 2-K waterborne polyurethane and UV curable coatings. In her current position she is looking at 1-component waterborne coatings on various substrates including wood, plastics, and metal applications.

ABSTRACT

Waterborne polyurethane coatings have an outstanding reputation for high performance in the areas of solvent resistance, abrasion resistance, hardness, and weathering. However, these outstanding properties come at a relatively high price, which has limited their application to markets where high performance is required. In recent years ever tightening environmental regulations have made the use of waterborne resins more desirable even at the higher cost. Waterborne coatings offer similar performance characteristics of traditional high VOC coatings but at much lower VOC content. Comparative examples will be shown for selected markets including concrete and metal coatings.



REQUIREMENTS

- The PSCT Board of Directors will determine the total amount of scholarship money to be awarded each year.
- The maximum dollar amount of each scholarship will be \$1500. Scholarship money will be awarded equally to students as recommended by the Scholarship Committee.
- Scholarship awards are to support undergraduate studies of full time students only en-rolled in an accredited college or university seeking an associate or bachelor degree.
- Scholarships may be awarded to any one given applicant a maximum of four times.
- Applicant must be the child of an actively participating PSCT member. An actively participating member is current with dues. The
 member must also attend at least four (4) PSCT meetings a year or serve on a PSCT committee (e.g.: Fund Raising, Newsletter, Membership, Education, Program, etc)
- Scholarships are limited to one award per applicant per member per year.
- Applicants must submit a Hiram P. Ball Memorial Scholarship Application which in-clude: a short essay explaining how the course of study will allow the student to reach their career goals; current GPA; name of sponsoring PSCT member; name of univer-sity or college that they are attending; and two character references. Students cur-rently receiving scholarships will not be required to submit references, however they must submit essays regarding their educational progress.
- Applicants must maintain a 2.5 (out of 4.0) grade average.
- The Scholarship Committee will consist of five PSCT Members who do not have a child or relative applying for a scholarship.
- COURSE OF STUDY: Although all courses of study are open, students are encouraged to pur-sue scientific, engineering or mathematical programs that lead to employment in the Coat-ings Industry.
